### Who are children and youth with special health care needs?

Anyone from birth to age 21, with a long term physical, developmental, behavioral or emotional illness or condition.

Some examples include:

- ★ Asthma, diabetes, sickle cell anemia, cystic fibrosis, childhood cancers and heart disease
  - ★ ADHD and mental health conditions
  - ★ Cognitive disabilities, Down syndrome, cerebral palsy and autism spectrum disorders
  - ★ Hearing and vision impairments
  - ★ Spina bifida, muscular dystrophy
- ...and many other health conditions

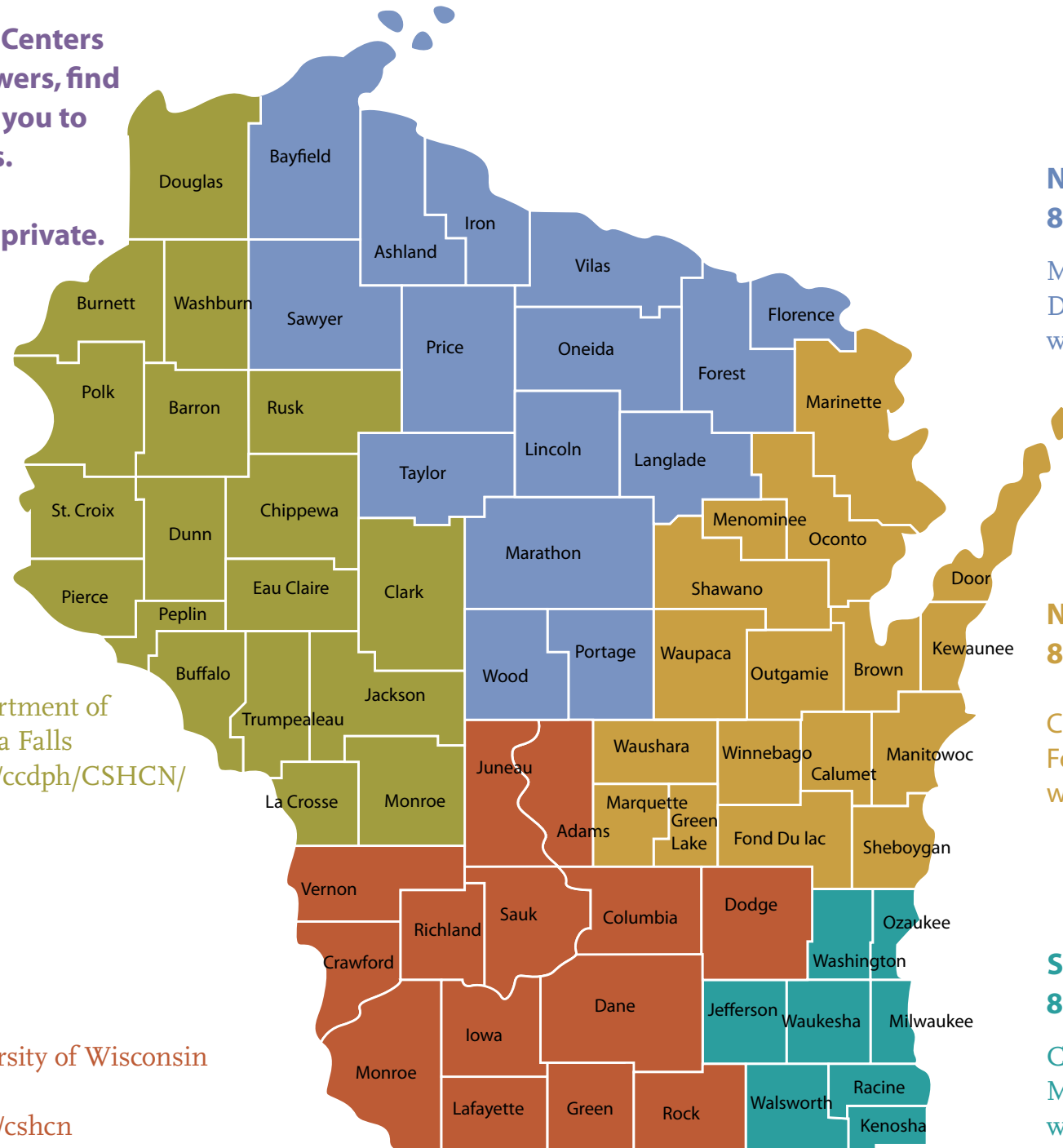
