

How to deal with the ' "problem" in Pepfont

Many of our Pepfont users have reported problems with generating certain phonetic symbols, particularly the theta symbol which is mapped to the single quote key. By disabling automatic correction features belonging to more recent versions of most wordprocessing applications, the Pepfont characters will be displayed and printed as one would expect.

WordPerfect's QuickCorrect (AutoCorrect in Microsoft Word) feature is designed to make automatic corrections and changes in your document, such as correcting frequently misspelled words, replacing quotation marks with open and close quote symbols, and automatically capitalizing the first word of a sentence. Although these features are helpful for most documents, they can cause confusion when using the Pepfont. For example, automatic capitalization would substitute a diacritic symbol for a main symbol, and replacing quotation marks would result in an undefined character for ' .

In WordPerfect, to turn off some of the QuickCorrect features:

1. Choose **Tools > QuickCorrect**. The **QuickCorrect** dialog box will open.
2. Uncheck the box to the left of **Replace words as you type**.
3. Click **Options**. The **QuickCorrect Options** dialog box will open.
4. Under **Sentence Corrections**, uncheck the boxes to the left of **Capitalize First Letter** and **Correct TWo Irregular Capitals**.
5. Uncheck the boxes to the left of **Turn On Single Quotes** and **Turn On Double Quotes**.
6. Click **OK** to close the **QuickCorrect Options** dialog box.
7. Click **Close**.

In Word, to turn off some of the AutoCorrect features:

1. Choose **Tools > AutoCorrect**. The **AutoCorrect** dialog box will open.
2. Select the **AutoCorrect** tab from the top panel; Uncheck the boxes to the left of all correction options.
3. Select the **AutoFormat as You Type** tab from the top panel; Uncheck the box to the left of **"Straight quotes" with "smart quotes"**.
4. Select the **AutoFormat** tab from the top panel; Uncheck the box to the left of **"Straight quotes" with "smart quotes"**.
5. Click **OK** to close the **AutoCorrect** dialog box.
